Clinical Teaching

Resident and Medical Student Teaching

As a member of the Department of Orthopaedics for the past 17 years, I have been actively teaching all Residents and Medical Students in the Operating Room and in Clinic. I have also been the Director of the Fellowship Program for Arthroscopic Reconstruction and Sports Medicine.

I am actively involved in teaching of Medical Students, Residents and Fellows 5 days a week every year. Each month there are 1 to 2 Residents that are assigned to our service for Clinical teaching. Medical Students routinely are also assigned to be involved in our Clinical activity for teaching. Fellows are present on our service for the entire year from August –July.

Teaching occurs in the Operating room up to 2 days per week and usually includes both a Fellow and a Resident. Within my clinic teaching occurs up to 3 days per week with Fellows and Residents managing new consults and follow up patients. In addition, non-patient teaching occurs during our Division rounds approximately once per month.

As the Fellowship Director, I coordinate and manage the clinical curriculum for the Fellowship. I undertake performance appraisals of the Fellows biannually and I am involved in their clinical research projects applying the principles of clinical epidemiology to the formulation of these studies.
